Refreshing apple and pear fruit, backed by plenty of fizz.  
Italy (NV ~ 11.5% abv) £14.95

Soft and sparkling with a lively effervescence, a perfect combination of fruit and acidity. Approachable and easy-drinking with a good length.

## House Wine

- (2) 1. **Chardonnay-Pinot Grigio del Veneto 'Vita'**  
 Excellent rich fruit balanced by the natural pear drop finish of the Pinot Grigio varietal. Using a blend of 85% Chardonnay and 15% Pinot Grigio.  
 Italy (2006/7 ~ 12% abv) £3.50 £4.50 £11.95
- (B) 2. **Merlot-Cabernet del Veneto 'Vita'**  
 Soft bilberry fruit balanced by the tannins of the Cabernet Franc varietal. Using a blend of Merlot and Cabernet with extended fermentation in stainless steel to extract colour and forward jammy fruit.  
 Italy (2005/6 ~ 12% abv) £3.50 £4.50 £11.95

## White Wine

- (4) 3. **Hardys 'The Riddle' Riesling-Gewürztraminer, SE Australia**  
 A combination of two classic aromatic grape varieties. Off-dry with tropical fruit and lychee characters lingering on the palate.  
 Australia (2005/6 ~ 12.5% abv) £12.95
- (2) 4. **Casa La Joya Unoaked Chardonnay, Colchagua Valley**  
 Yellowish-green, bright colour, fresh and lemony, rounded and well-balanced wine with a good finish.  
 Chile (2006/7 ~ 13.5% abv) £12.95
- (2) 5. **Frascati Villa d'Oro**  
 A stylish and delicious, dry white with a fresh zesty bouquet and a ripe almond flavour. From one of the region's best producers.  
 Italy (2006/7 ~ 12% abv) £13.95
- (2) 6. **Chateau Indage Tiger Hill Chardonnay-Semillon, Sahyadri Valley**  
 Aromas of lemon, apple and stone fruit are mirrored in the soft, smooth finish.  
 India (2006 ~ 13% abv) £15.95
- (1) 7. **Short Mile Bay Sauvignon Blanc, SE Australia**  
 Lifted and aromatic tropical fruits of pineapple and passion fruit, combined with grapefruit, citrus and hints of capsicum produce a crisp Sauvignon Blanc with a lingering finish.  
 Australia (2006/7 ~ 12% abv) £16.95
- (2) 8. **Torres Viña Esmeralda, Penedés**  
 Blending aromatic Muscat with the spicy Gewürztraminer results in this popular dry white which is both floral and fragrant.  
 Spain (2006/7 ~ 11.5% abv) £16.95
- (1) 9. **Nobilo Southern Rivers Sauvignon Blanc, East Coast**  
 Fresh and crisp with classic characters of gooseberry and tropical flavours. Excellent weight and mouthfeel and a dry, lingering finish.  
 New Zealand (2005/6 ~ 13% abv) £17.95
- (1) 10. **Chablis, Paul Deloux**  
 Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.  
 France (2005/6 ~ 12% abv) £22.95
- (1) 11. **Sancerre Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot**  
 A stylish, crisp Sauvignon with the tell-tale aroma of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish.

## Red Wine

- (B) 12. **Casa La Joya Merlot, Colchagua Valley**  
 Deep ruby colour, dry and velvety on the palate. A fruity and light wine with the aromas and flavours of cherry and raspberry.  
 Chile (2005/6 ~ 13.5% abv) £12.95
- (C) 13. **Vendange Zinfandel, California**  
 Deep-coloured, full-bodied and spicy using California's 'own' grape variety with rich meaty flavours and soft, rich tannins.  
 U.S.A. (2002/3 ~ 13% abv) £13.95
- (D) 14. **Chateau Indage Tiger Hill Merlot-Shiraz, Sahyadri Valley**  
 A spicy, plum-driven, silky, red from the land of the tiger.  
 India (2006 ~ 13% abv) £15.95
- (A) 15. **Short Mile Bay Cabernet Sauvignon, SE Australia**  
 Powerful blackcurrant and blackberry Cabernet Sauvignon characters well complemented by spicy cinnamon and cigar box notes from well integrated oak. A rich, intense wine.  
 Australia (2004/5 ~ 14% abv) £15.95
- (C) 16. **Cullinan View Pinotage, Robertson,**  
 Rich, full and spicy with good levels of fruit aromas and flavour, made with South Africa's own grape variety.  
 South Africa (2005/6 ~ 12.5% abv) £17.95
- (C) 17. **Errázuriz Merlot-Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley**  
 Full-bodied and fruity, combining two popular grape varieties. Aromas of blackberry and cherry, red pepper and coffee on the palate with toasted vanilla flavour combine to provide good complexity.  
 Chile (2004/5 ~ 13.5% abv) £17.95
- (D) 18. **Chianti Superiore Il Leo, Ruffino**  
 Vibrant cherry and violet-scented Sangiovese, backed by a smooth, yet refreshing finish.  
 Italy (2005 ~ 13% abv) £18.95
- (C) 19. **Don Jacobo, Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Corral**  
 Very traditional Rioja, with plenty of vanilla-oak character after 3 years in oak. Beautiful silky balance and a soft mature finish.  
 Spain (2001 ~ 12.5% abv) £25.95

- (D) 20. **Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Cuvée Tradition, Caves Saint-Pierre**  
 Deep ruby in colour and very full-bodied, with a heady, spicy bouquet, ripe fruit and a long velvety finish.  
 France (2005/6 ~ 13.5% abv) £31.95

## Rosé Wine

- (3) 21. **Hardys Stamp of Australia Grenache-Shiraz, SE Australia**  
 This blend displays fresh fruit and floral characters. Rose, violet, strawberry and raspberry characters combine in this crisp, fresh wine ideal for summer picnics.  
 Australia (2007/8 ~ 12% abv) £3.75 £4.95 £13.95
- (4) 22. **Mateus Rosé, Sogrape Vinhos de Portugal**  
 Soft, strawberry fruit on the nose and a gentle taste, enlivened with a slight sparkle. It is easy to understand why this famous Portuguese rosé is so popular.
